Deborah Gilshan is Corporate Governance Counsel at Railpen Investments, the investment management arm of the Railways Pension Trustee Company, the trustee of for the pension funds of the railway industry in the UK. With assets under management of around £15 billion, Railpen is one of the UK's largest occupational pension funds, and Deborah is responsible for the implementation of Railpen's global corporate governance and shareholder engagement policies, with her specific focus being on the UK, USA and Australia. Prior to joining Railpen in November 2007, Deborah managed corporate governance and engagement at Co-operative Insurance Society, having started her governance career there in December 2000.

Deborah is an Associate of the UK's Institute of Chartered Secretaries and Administrators. She holds the Institute's Professional Award in Corporate Governance and is an Advisor to them on governance issues from the perspective of an investor. Whilst qualifying as a Chartered Secretary, Deborah was awarded the Institute's prizes for her papers on corporate governance, financial accounting and corporate administration. Deborah holds Unit 1 (UK Regulation and Markets) of the CFA's Investment Management Certificate and is currently studying for Unit 2 (Investment Practice).
